If you need to go somewhere on your own at night, one of the UW Safe Nighttime Services can offer reliable and safe transportation or escorts. A valid UW-Madison ID is required.

SAFEwalk provides two-person teams who watch for unsafe situations on campus and can escort you anywhere on campus (except the far west side). SAFEwalk is currently available from 8 pm until 1 am.

SAFERide bus service runs three circular routes from 6:30 pm to 1:30 am Sunday through Thursday and until 3 am on Friday and Saturday:

Route 80 Memorial Union/Eagle Heights

Route 81 Lakeshore Dorms/Langdon-Johnson

Route 82 Regent-Breese/Bedford-Broom

SAFERide cabs can help when you are outside the SAFEwalk zone or away from a SAFERide bus route. Students can get four SAFERide cab rides per month. A \$1 donation and a tip for the cab driver are recommended. SAFERide cabs are available regularly from 10:30 pm to 3 am and during final exam week until 6 am.
